
Guest Information

Following is information and helpful hints for your upcoming trip to Beqa Lagoon Resort. Please be advised that this information is only a guideline and information is subject to change.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Bula - This is the Fijian greeting you will hear often while on your vacation in Fiji.

Bure - This refers to the traditional Fijian style bungalow. For your comfort, all of our bures have air-conditioning, ceiling fans and screened windows.



Electrical Power - Beqa Lagoon Resort is equipped with 240 Volts with Australian style socket with 3 prongs. You will need an adaptor and converter for your electrical appliances. We do have a 110 volt panel in the office for those who need to charge cell phones or camera batteries.

Drinking Water - Our drinking water is pure, spring water from the mountains on Beqa Island that is safe to drink. Bottled water is also available for purchase or fill your water bottles with filtered water holder located in the main dining room.

Dining - you will choose your menu daily at breakfast time. The options vary each day and several choices at each meal. We also have a wide selection of vegetarian dishes. If you have any special dietary restrictions, please let us know and our kitchen staff will gladly accommodate your needs. Dining is family style, however, tables may be arranged for couples or smaller groups. NO SMOKING IN THE DINING AREA PLEASE.

Dress - Casual. lightweight clothing is suggested. If you wish to visit the local villages, ladies will need to wear clothing covering legs and shoulders and no hats for men and women. We recommend you bring a light sweater or windbreaker for possible showers or mild evening breezes.

Finances - There is no money transaction during your stay at Beqa Lagoon Resort. All purchases/charges will be applied to your rooms incidental account and finalized upon your departure. We accept MC, Visa, Amex, Travelers Checks and cash (USD OR FJD).

Laundry Service - available at a nominal fee

Lali Spa - Relax and Unwind at our beachfront, open-air Lali Spa. We offer a full range of service including couples massages, hot seashell massage and much, much more. Exotic oils and potions from the Pure Fiji product line are featured at our spa.

Tipping - Individual tipping is not customary in Fiji. Staff members do not expect to be tipped at any time. If you have enjoyed your stay and the service you have received, you are encouraged to show your appreciation by contributing to the employee Christmas Fund when you depart. All of the Fijian staff will share this fund at the end of the year.

Telephone Service - Individual bures do not have phones. If you wish to place or receive a call, you may use the office phone for a minimal cost. Most cell phones work on the island, so check with your carrier regarding this service.

Internet Service - Beqa Lagoon Resort does have wifi available in the main dining areas and in your bures. Cost is approx \$12 USD per day or \$70 USD per week.

Village Visits - During your stay at Beqa, there will be opportunities to visit the local school and church. Some of our guests like to bring school supplies and miscellaneous donations. Small gifts are appreciated.

Handicapp Facilities - Due to our remote setting, we are somewhat limited as to what types of wheelchairs and other handicapp devices can be comfortably used at Beqa. Please inquire and we will be happy to discuss our resort setting in detail with you to see if is suitable for your needs.
